



#### 1 P1 Switch

Preset position 1 (Used mainly for shampooing position)

### 2 P2 Switch

Preset Position 2 (Used mainly with the backrest upright)

How to set the preset position

- 1) P1: Set the chair to the desired position
  - P2: Set the chair backrest to the desired position
- 2) Turn off the main switch
- 3) While depressing the Preset Switch (P1 or P2), turn on the main switch
- 4) Keep depressing the Preset Switch until the buzzer sounds, then release

#### 3 Auto Return Switch

- $\bigcirc$  Chair will move to the initial position automatically
- 4 Lock Position Switch

LPC Lock/unlock the chair rotating position




To adjust the temperature over 40 degrees, turn the knob while pressing the Stop Button






1 Attach the Neck Cushion and Head Pillow.




2 Attach both sides of the Neck Cushion with snap button.






1 Turn on the power.




2 Press the auto return switch to bring the chair to its initial position.




Instruct the customer to sit from the side, then face front.




4 Press the P1 switch (or manual mode control) to bring the chair to its approximate position.










The basin top height should match the practitioner's hip












6 After the shampooing, return the chair to its initial position.




7 Wipe off the remaining water after use.




8 Clean the consumable parts.



1 Press the P2 switch to bring the backrest to its upright position.




2 Press the lock position switch to unlock the chair rotation.




The chair lock will not release when the backrest is within 30 degrees.



Rotate the chair to the desired position by gently holding onto the backrest
 ⇒ A clicking sound can be heard at the 60 and 90 degrees point




4 Press the lock position switch to lock the chair rotation.






Confirm that there are no objects/people in the way when rotating the chair.



When finished, unlock the chair to return it to its initial position (0 $^{\circ}$  ), and lock.





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
