Precautions for Use





Do not subject the trolley to impact.

Do not subject the trolley to impact by bringing hard objects into contact with the trolley or toppling or dropping it on the floor. Deformation of the trolley or injury from the damaged trolley may result



Do not use for any purpose other than hairdressing salon treatment.

This product is an industrial appliance for use in hairdressing salons. Please avoid the use of the product outside these purposes.



Be careful not to get the trolley wet.

Be careful not to get the trolley wet. If it gets wet, wipe off the moisture immediately. Otherwise, the product may gather rust or malfunction.



Wipe off any chemicals that adhere to the product.

If chemicals adhere to the product, immediately wipe these off with a dry cloth because such contact may result in degeneration and discolouration. In particular, take extra care not to stain the product with hair dye.



Do not subject the trolley to direct sunlight or heat from space

Be careful not to expose the trolley to direct sunlight or heat from space heaters. Parts of the trolley may discolor or deteriorate, or the trolley may become hot, resulting in injury.



Do not place excessively heavy objects on the trays. Do not place a load that exceeds 50 N (5 kgf) on any of the trays. Deformation or other damage to the product may result. Also, the product may fall, resulting in injury.

Maintenance Method	
A CAUTION	The following cleaners must not be used on the product: volatile chemicals, such as thinner, alcohol, gasoline, or kerosene; abrasive waxes or sponges; detergent containing organic solvents; acid, alkaline, or chlorine-based detergents; or dish scrubbers. Use of these materials may become a remote cause of scratches on the product or discoloration of the product.
Frame Trays	Wipe gently with a dry, soft cloth. If the frame or trays become wet, wipe off the moisture immediately. Otherwise, the frame or tray may gather rust or break down. If the frame or trays become heavily stained, remove the stains with a neutral detergent mixed with water, and be sure to wipe the frame or tray with a dry cloth.
Casters	If hair or dirt becomes caught in the casters and they do not roll smoothly, clean the casters. Note: During cleaning, be careful not to get your fingers caught by the moving parts.

Standard Period of Use

Standard period of use for this product is three years. Standard period of use is defined as "a guideline for the standard period of using the product without any problems in safety under standard conditions of product use with appropriate maintenance and inspection (including replacement of parts) performed. "Please be advised that this is not an indication of the guarantee period.

Consumable Goods

"Consumable goods" listed below refer to parts that are expected to undergo wear, deterioration, and changes/damage in appearance with use. Please be advised that the repair and replacement of consumable goods are not covered under the guarantee and will incur a charge. (*Degree and timing of wear, deterioration, and damage varies depending on the environment conditions the product is used.) In the case of significant wear and deterioration or damage, inspection or replacement of the parts will be necessary. Please contact your local authorised Takara Belmont dealer immediately.
